Monday, May 29 – Memorial Day USA -Day 1 – DEPART USA –

Today we depart Detroit on our overnight flight to Europe aboard a wide-bodied jet. We enjoy in-flight movies, dinner and breakfast aloft.

Tuesday, May 30-DAY 2 - ROME - We arrive in Europe this

morning and connect to Rome where we meet our tour manager, board our motor coach and drive to our hotel. On route we drive by the Roman Fora, the Arch of Constantine, the Coliseum and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Time Permitting, we conclude our day at one of the Catacombs, burial place of early Christians. Time permitting, we celebrate Mass here and view the 2nd and 3rd century fresco paintings. Continue to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Wednesday, May 31 – Pentecost, Sunday June 4-DAYS 3 -7 – ROME – These days will be spent on activities for the Worldwide Catholic Charismatic Renewal Gathering in Rome. **Unitours provides Hotel with breakfast and dinner daily. On two of these days, we provide transfers from hotel to someplace in Rome environs and then later return the group to the hotel. Optional excursions will be offered on site for those wishing them.**

Monday, June 5 - DAY 8 – ROME/USA – For those not continuing to the Holy Land, we will transfer to the airport for our return trip to Detroit.

Monday, June 5 - DAY 8 – ROME/TEL AVIV/TIBERIAS – For

those continuing on to the Holy Land we will transfer to the airport for our flight to Tel Aviv. Upon arrival in Tel Aviv we are met and begin our sightseeing. We begin our pilgrimage driving north to Caesarea, capital of the Roman Procurators of Judea and then continue to Mt. Carmel, where Elijah called on God to defeat the Priests of Baal. We will celebrate Mass here before proceeding to our hotel along the Sea of Galilee for dinner and overnight.

Tuesday, June 6 - DAY 9 - TIBERIAS –

This morning we take a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum, then visit Tabgha and the Church of Primacy. We pray at the Mount of Beatitudes, overlooking the beautiful Sea of Galilee. This afternoon, we visit Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus and the place where Mary received the message from the Angel that she would conceive and bear a son and call him Jesus. We celebrate this event with Mass at the beautiful Church of the Annunciation. Finally, we visit Cana, the town of Jesus' first miracle and have an opportunity to renew our marriage and vocational vows. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Wednesday, June 7 - DAY 10 – TIBERIAS/JERUSALEM - This morning, we stop at the River Jordan to renew our Baptismal vows before we make the exciting drive to the summit of Mt. Tabor for a magnificent view of the plains of Estraelon and celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Transfiguration on Mt. Tabor. Afterwards, we follow the Rift Valley that runs parallel to the Jordan, following the route Jesus most frequently traveled to Jerusalem. We visit Qumran and the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Afterwards, we make a short stop at the clear yet salty waters of the Dead Sea, the lowest place

on earth. On route to Jerusalem, we pass by the traditional site of the Inn of the Good Samaritan. Finally, we make our thrilling entry into Jerusalem and continue to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Thursday, June 8 - DAY 11 - JERUSALEM - Today we drive to the

Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of Jerusalem.

Visit the Church of Pater Noster, the Church of Dominus Flevit - where Jesus wept over Jerusalem and where we celebrate Mass. We then proceed to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations. We drive through the Kidron Valley passing the Tombs of Absalom, Zechariah and St. James. Visit the Pool of Siloam and the Church of St. Peter of Gallicantu (Caiaphas' House.) This afternoon we enter the Old City through the Zion Gate on the way to the Western (Wailing) Wall where we have time to pray. Visit the Dome of the Rock on the Temple Mount. Visit the Church of St. Anne, the Pool of Bethesda, Pilate's Judgment Hall, the Chapel of the Flagellation, Lithostrotos, Arch of Ecce Homo (Behold the Man.) We then carry the cross as we pray the Stations of the cross along the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Return to our hotel for dinner and

overnight.

Friday, June 9 - DAY 12 - JERUSALEM - This morning our excursion begin in Bethlehem and the Church of the Nativity that commemorates the birth of Christ. We visit Manger Square, the

Manger and proceed to Shepherd's Field where we celebrate Mass in the beautiful grotto church of the Franciscan's.

Afterward we visit the New City of Jerusalem, Mount Zion, the Upper Room, the Tomb of King David and Dormition Abbey. This afternoon we visit the Model City of Jerusalem in Jesus' time, Ein Karem and the Church of the Visitation where Mary visited Elizabeth, the birthplace of John the Baptist. We pass by the Knesset (Israel Parliament.) Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Saturday, June 10 - DAY 13 -

JERUSALEM/TEL AVIV/U.S. – Early this morning, we transfer to the airport for our flight home with the unforgettable memories to cherish always. Knowing that we have walked in the footsteps of Jesus and the early Christians bring new meaning to our Scripture reading because of such a memorable pilgrimage.

TOTAL TOUR PRICE: The tour price is based on airfare, cruise, land rates and rates of exchange in effect September 4, 2015. All rates are subject to change without prior notice. Should the rates go up or down, an adjustment would be made prior to departure. Refunds CANNOT be granted for any accommodations, services or events that are not used nor if you deviate from the tour. If fewer than 45 pilgrims participate a price adjustment may be necessary.

PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS: A valid passport is required. At the time of printing, U.S. citizens holding valid passports DO NOT REQUIRE visas or immunization for the country or countries being visited. Passport MUST be valid until **December 10, 2017** or later. Citizens of countries other than U.S. - please contact the consulate of the country or countries being visited to determine visa requirements.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: International flight reservations are being held on Delta, Alitalia and Air France. No stopovers are permitted. Any changes after ticket is issued, carries a mandatory charge of \$200. Once the tickets are issued, they are NON REFUNDABLE. Additional non-recoverable airline penalties of up to \$200 may be assessed for cancellations received within 90 days of departure

DOMESTIC AIRFARE: For those who make domestic air arrangements to the originating city of this tour, your tour host and Unitours strongly recommend the purchase of tickets that can be changed without heavy fees and penalties as international flight schedules are always subject to change.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: Specially selected hotels based on twin occupancy with private bath. Single Room supplement of \$925 (\$481 for Rome only option) will be charged where requested and available. If you do not have a roommate and Unitours is unable to arrange one, you will be billed for the single room supplement. All singles are subject to availability.

MEALS: Breakfast and Table D' Hote dinners are provided daily except where noted in the itinerary. An extra charge will be made when coffee, tea or other beverages are not included in the menu of the day with the dinner meal.

TIPS AND TAXES: Tips and taxes normally appearing on hotel and restaurant bills as service are included, as are all government and local taxes on hotels and meals, portage of one suitcase per person. International departure taxes of \$172 plus current fuel surcharges of \$695 are included (subject to change). TIPS TO TOUR MANAGER/GUIDES, DRIVERS OR DINING ROOMS STAFF OF \$120 (\$69 FOR ROME ONLY) ARE NOT INCLUDED. One average sized suitcase not exceeding 50 lbs total weight and 62 linear inches (height plus width plus depth is permitted throughout the trip.

NOT INCLUDED: Expenses and items not specifically mentioned in this brochure are NOT covered, including but not limited to: passport and visa fees, meals not listed and items of a personal nature such as laundry, wines, liquors, mineral waters, after dinner coffee or tea, sightseeing or services other than those specifically mentioned, tips and taxes mentioned above, excess baggage and insurance, etc.

DEPOSITS AND CANCELLATIONS: A deposit of \$300 is required to secure reservations. Any balance is to be paid in full no later than 60 days before departure of tour. Final payments received at Unitours after 45 days before departure must include a \$25 late payment fee. (This does not apply for new reservations made after 45 days of departure.) Reservations made within 60 days of departure must include full payment. Amex, Visa and Mastercard are accepted with signed reservation form. Final payments will be applied to same credit card on final payment due date. Cancellations made from time of reservation to within 61 days prior to departure - - \$100 processing charge plus any air penalties noted above. In the event of a

cancellation from 60 to 8 days of departure - - \$150 processing charge plus up to 50% of the land cost, plus any air penalties noted above. There can be no refund for any services for cancellations received within 7 days of departure. All cancellation and refund claims must be in writing to Unitours, Inc.

BANK FEE: A fee of \$50 will be charged for any check that is returned to us for insufficient or unavailable funds.

DEVIATIONS: A service charge of \$50 pp will be applied for any deviations made in tour, (where possible), PLUS any additional air or land charges incurred.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: Optional Travel Insurance is strongly recommended for your trip. See www.Unitours.com/TravelInsurance for full details. Cost of travel insurance for this trip is \$378.
