LONDON – Depending upon our arrival time in London, our day will include a visit to the gothic

Westminster Abbey, location of coronations, royal weddings, funerals, and other state occasions. After our visit to the Abbey, we relax and refresh with the ultimate of British traditions, afternoon tea before checking into our hotel. of Mary - Day 3 - LONDON - After breakfast at our hotel, we begin to discover this historic and royal city. We begin with a morning private Mass at Westminster Cathedral, the seat of the Catholic Church in England. Afterwards we visit the State Rooms of Ruskingham Palace, the official

Buckingham Palace, the official residence of King Charles III. At the end of the visit, we have an independent lunch at the palace's café on the terrace overlooking the palace garden. In the afternoon we visit the Tower of

London: its medieval palace and prison and home of the Crown Jewels and get a great view of the iconic Tower Bridge. We return to our hotel and have a free evening for an independent dinner, theatre, concerts, London Ghost walk or visit an English pub. (B) Overnight London

Thursday, August 22 - Day 4 – LONDON - Following breakfast at our hotel we enjoy an independent day in London. The city has endless attractions, and this is the chance to explore your interests: independently pre-book a visit the Palace of Westminster, commonly known as the Houses of Parliament, explore The British Museum, The National Gallery, shopping at Harrod's, The Royal Mews, or the lush greenery of the city's parks. Saturday, August 24 - DAY 6 LONDON/INVERNESS — We depart

London to Inverness and explore the

Sunday, August 25 - Day 7 - INVERNESS/GLAMIS/ DUNDEE -

This morning we continue to explore the countryside by departing early along the way we stop for lunch and visit Blair Athol Distillery for a tour and taste of the spirits of Scotland. Following our included lunch, we arrive at Glamis Castle and its gardens, the ancestral seat to the Earls of Strathmore and Kinghorne since 1372, the inspiration for Shakespeare's Macbeth, the childhood home of Queen Elizabeth, the Queen Mother and birthplace of Princess Margaret. After our visit we travel to the nearby town of Dundee to check into our hotel and enjoy an independent dinner on our own. Overnight in Dundee (B, L) Monday, August 26 - Day 8 -

DUNDEE/ EDINBURGH – This morning we depart for Edinburgh and begin our discovery of the city at Edinburgh Castle, the centerpiece of the city. It sits upon Castle Rock, the remains of a dormant volcano. The castle was constr4ucted in the 12th century and has been the site of tumultuous historical events spanning hundreds of years. Inside the castle we view the Crown Jewels of Scotland, the Stone of Scone, and the Royal Chambers. We exit the castle precincts onto the Royal Mile making our way to

St. Giles Cathedral, founded in 1124. We enjoy an independent lunch on the Royal Mile. We then continue to the Palace of Holyroodhouse, the King's official residence in Scotland and associated with some of Scotland's most well-known historic figures such as Mary, Queen of Scots and Bonnie Prince Charlie. We visit the staterooms, palace gardens and the remains of Holyrood Abbey. This evening is free for a independent dinner on our own. (B) Overnight in Edinburg Tuesday, August 27 - Day 9 -EDINBURGH - Today is your day to independently explore the Scottish capital. Options include a visit to the National Gallery, the Royal Yacht Britannia, stop for tea, or spend time shopping. We gather later in the day for a special visit to Rosslyn Chapel. The chapel was found in 1446 and is one of Scotland's most remarkable buildings. We celebrate the conclusion of our trip with a special farewell visit and reception. Overnight in Edinburgh.

Wednesday, August 28 - Day 10 - EDINBURG/USA After breakfast, we transfer to the airport for our flight home with unforgettable memories. (B)

Passport MUST be valid until February 28, 2026, or later. Citizens of countries other than U.S. please contact the consulate of the country or countries being visited to determine visa requirements.

AİR TRANSPORTATION: International flight reservations are being held on Air Canada. No stopovers are permitted. Any changes after ticket is issued carries a mandatory charge of \$200. Once the tickets are issued, they are NON-

TRANSFERABLE AND NON-REFUNDABLE. Any requests to change a ticket once issued will incur a reissue fee of \$200 plus any fare differential will apply. Cancellation of air seat within 90 days of departure will incur a \$200 penalty.

DOMESTIC AIRFARE: For those who make domestic air arrangements to the originating city of this tour, your tour host and Unitours strongly recommend the purchase of tickets that can be changed without heavy fees and penalties as international flight schedules are always <u>subject to change</u>.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: Specially selected hotels based on twin occupancy with private bath. Single Room supplement of \$1,275 will be charged where requested and available.
